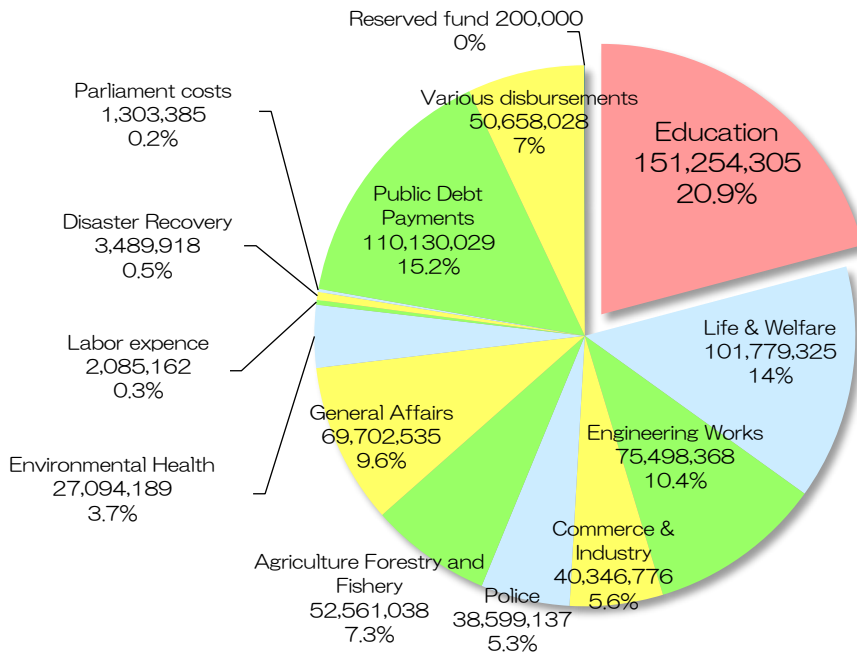

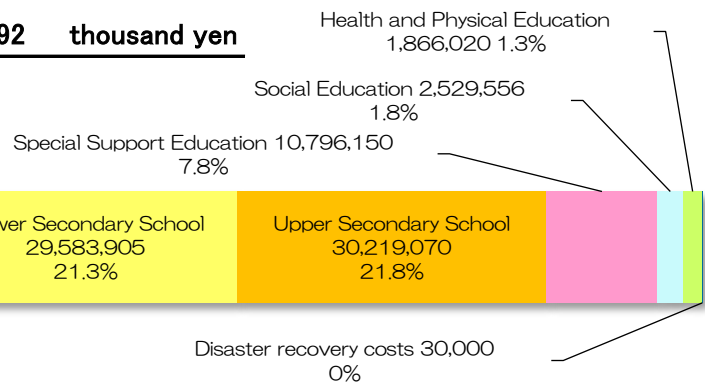

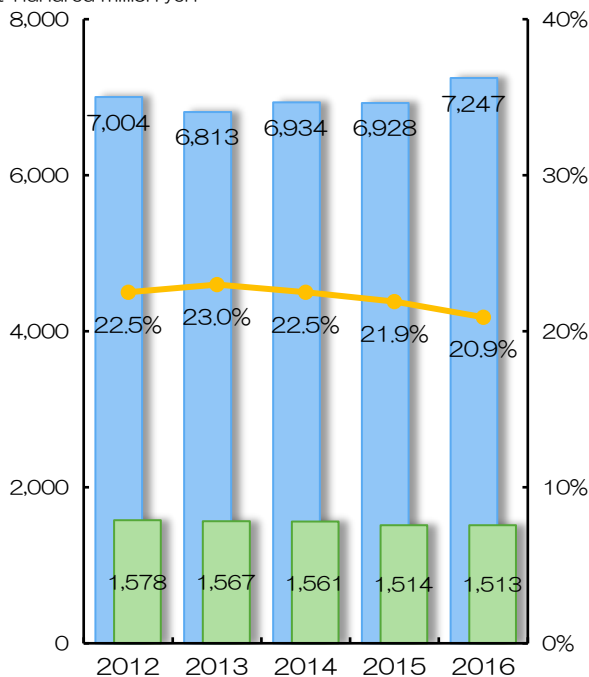

Unit: hundred million yen



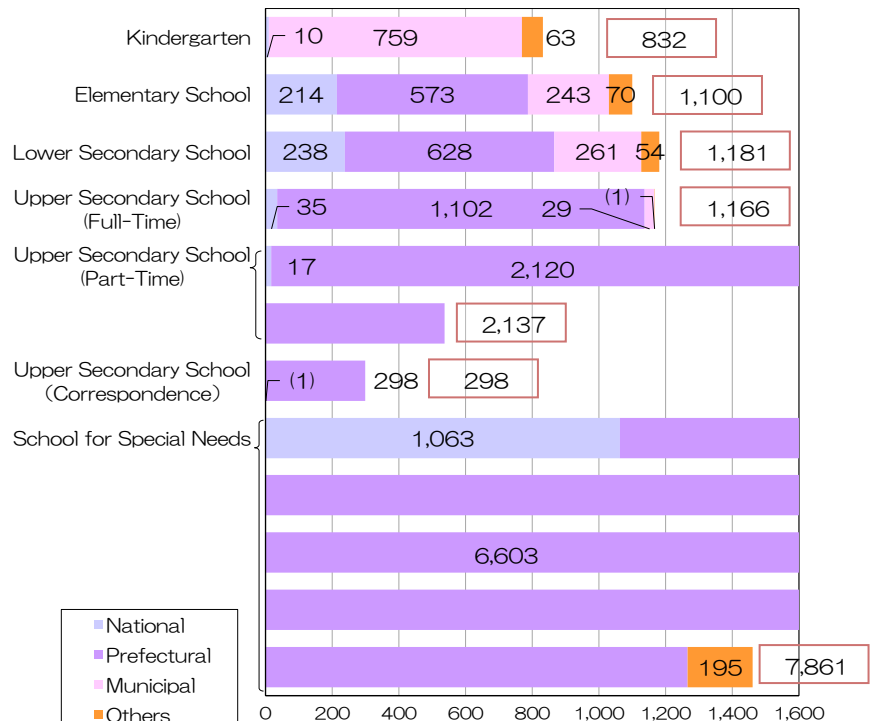

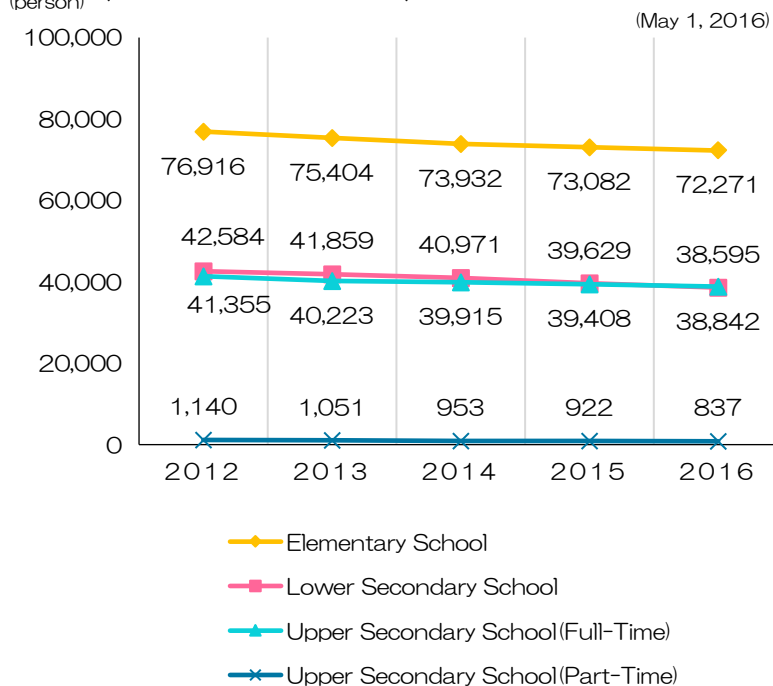

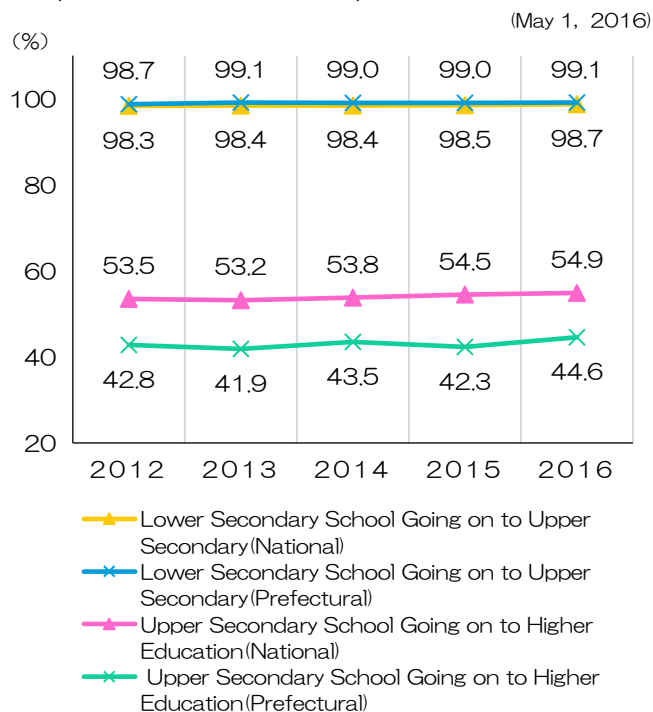

Changes in the Number of Students (National·Public·Private)



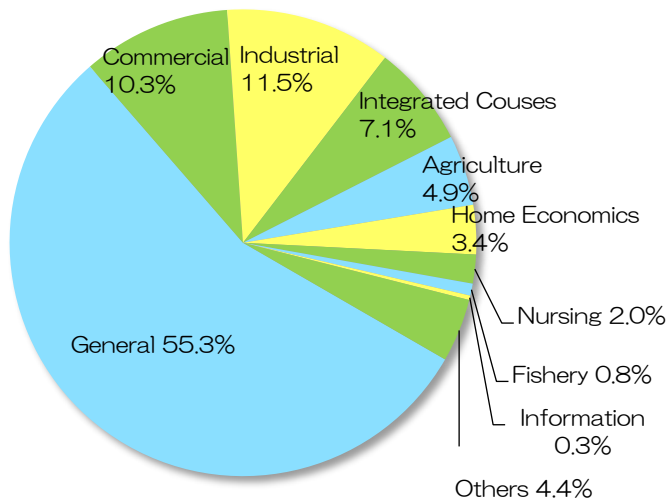
Changes of Enrollment Rate (National·Public·Private)

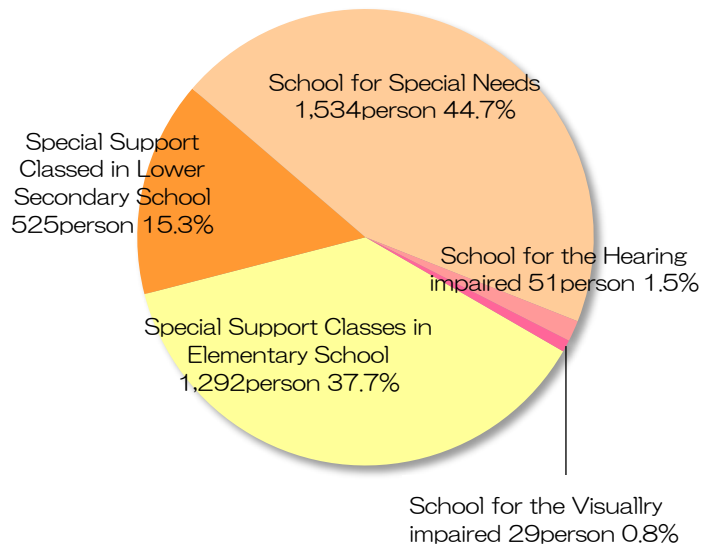

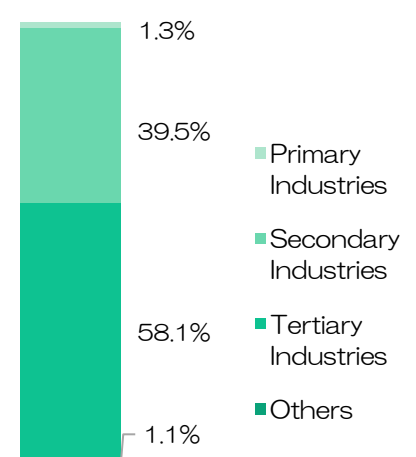

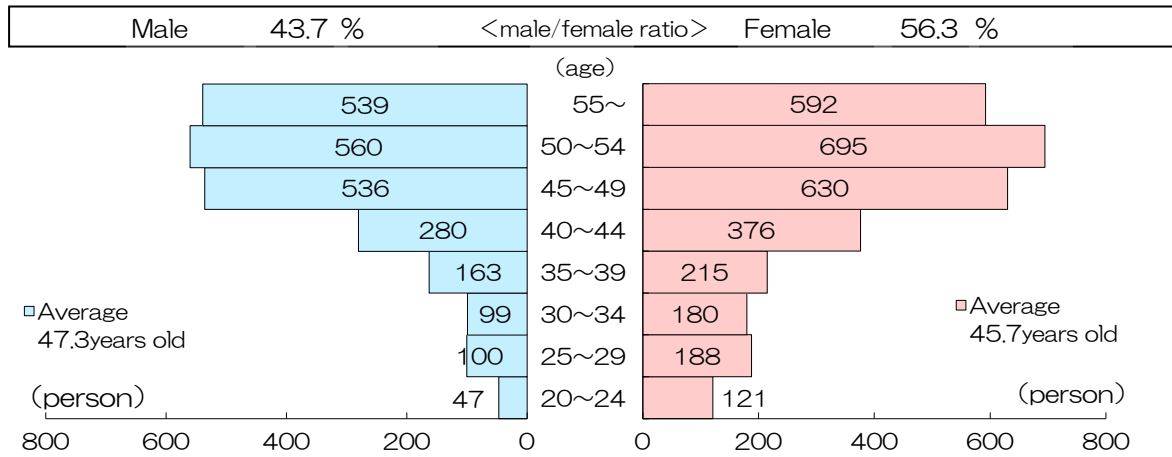

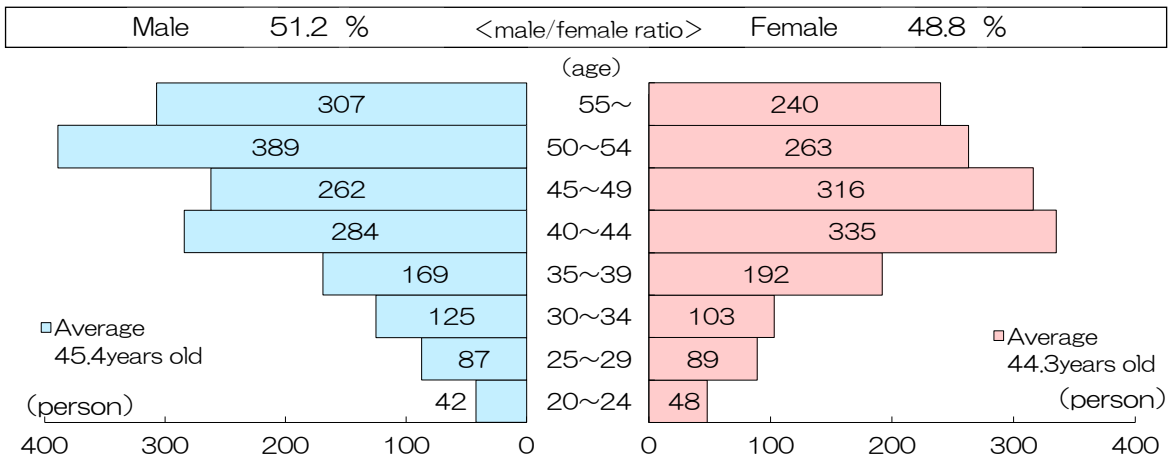
Number of Teachers, by Age

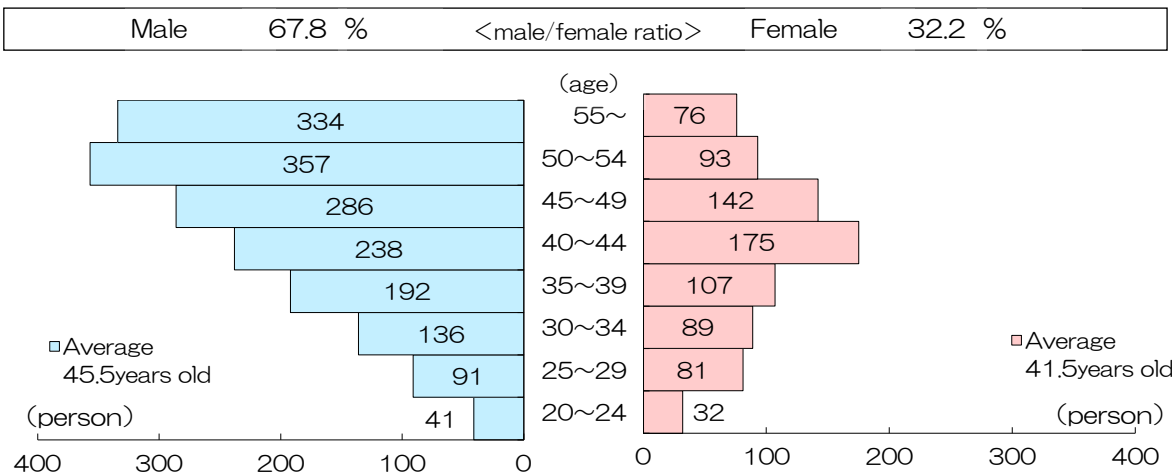

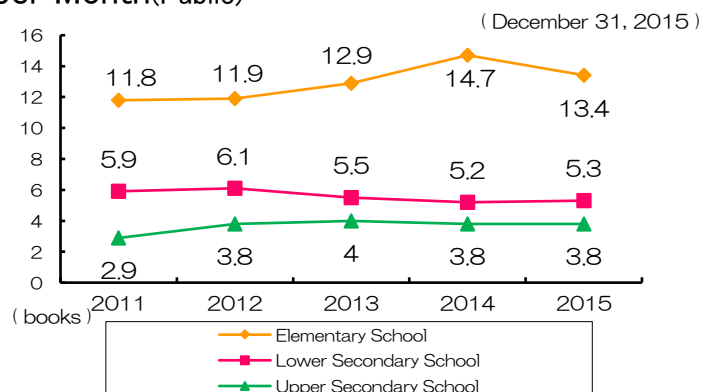

Average Number of Books Read by Children per Month(Public)



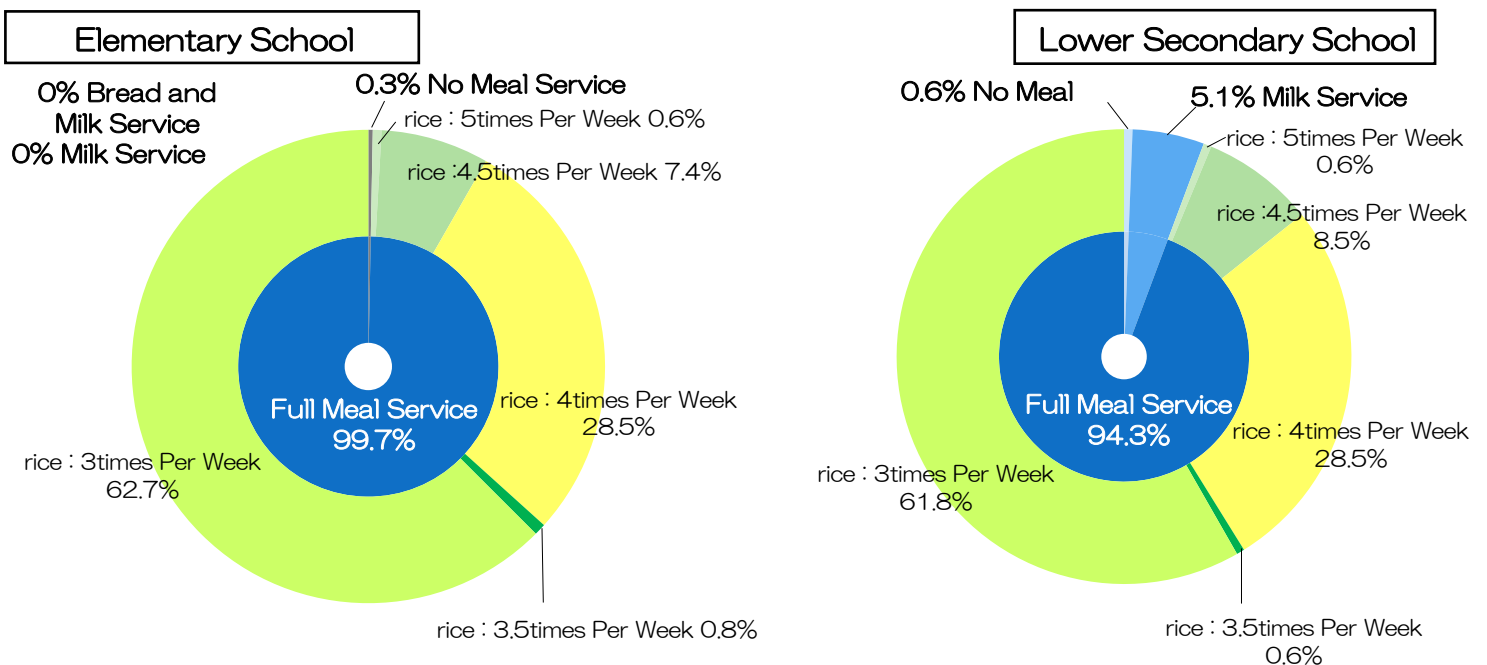

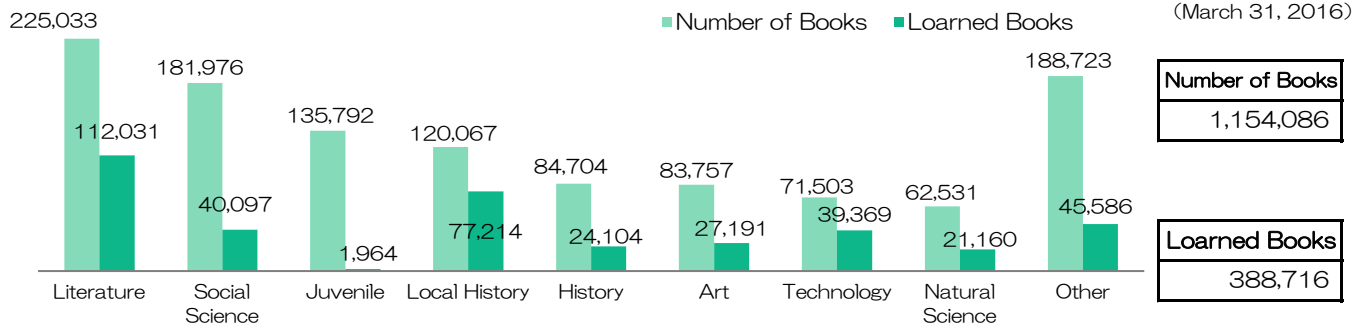

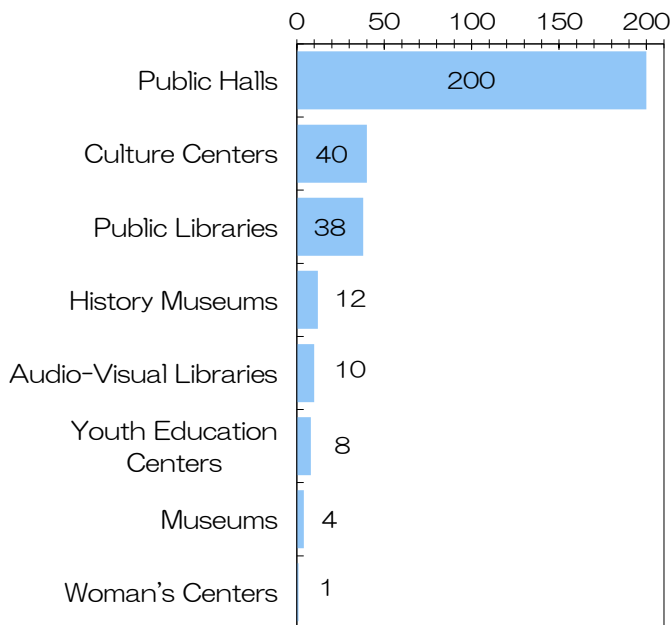

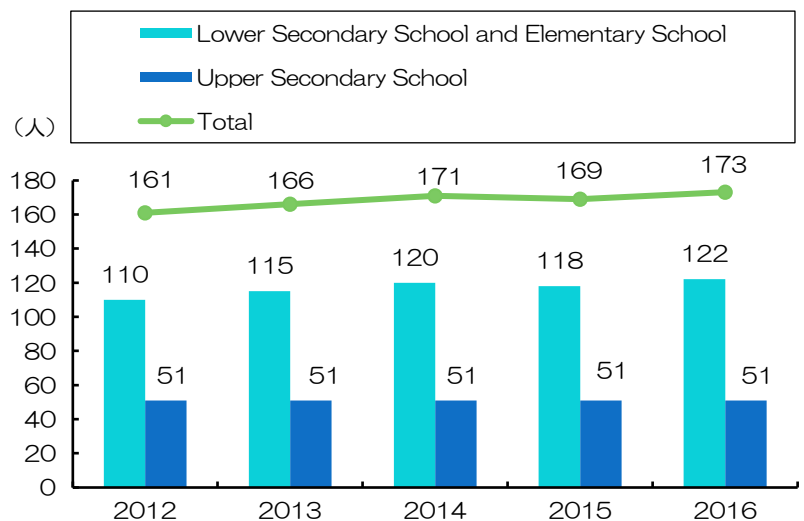

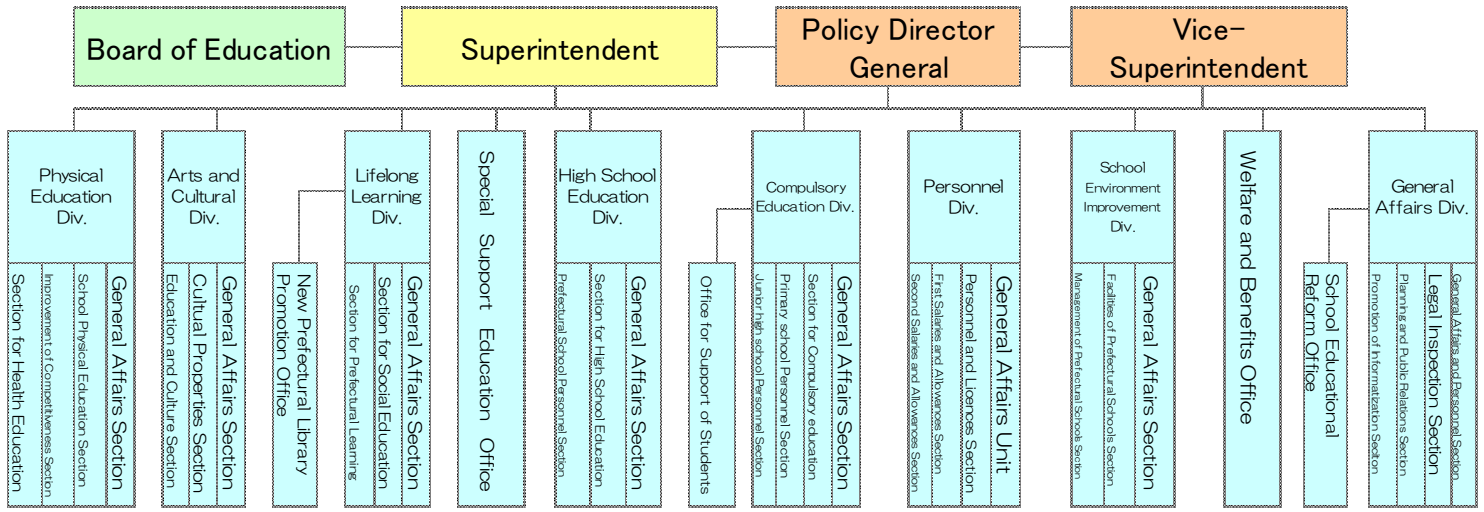
