



#### Nagasaki Prefecture Educational Policy





## Prefectural Budget and Educational Expenditures ☐ Total Budget 697,708,305 thousand yen








### Changes of Enrollment Rate (National Public Private)




- Lower Secondary School Going on to Upper Secondary(National)

- Upper Secondary School Going on to Higher Education (Prefectural)








### Total Numbers of Volumes and Loan Statistics in The Prefectural Library


