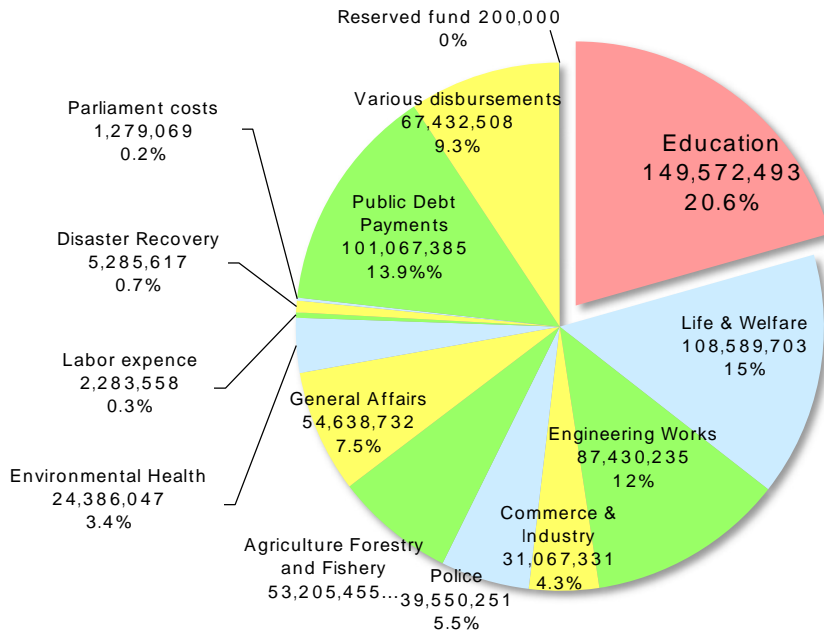

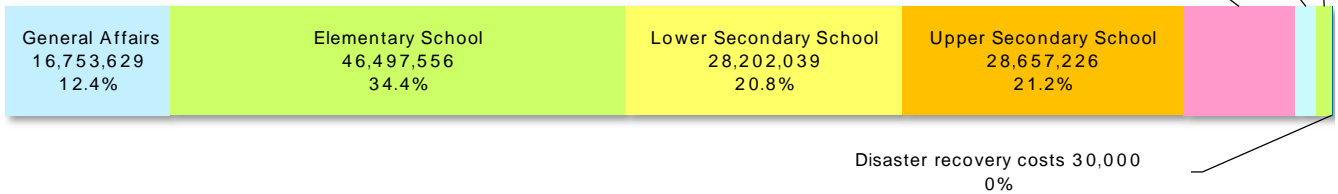

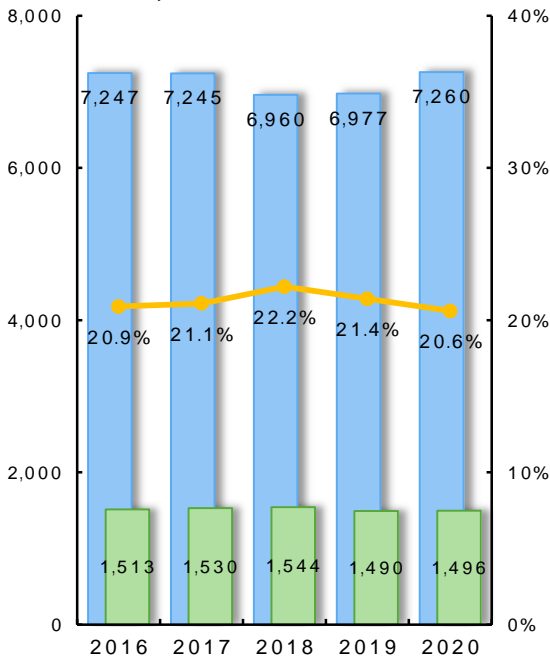

Unit: hundred million yen

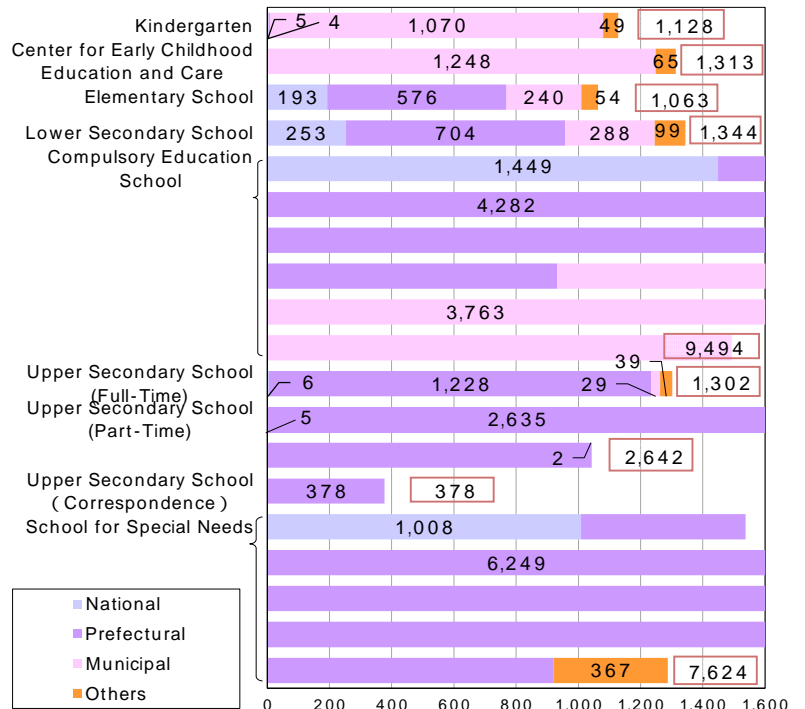


Educational Expenditure Per Student

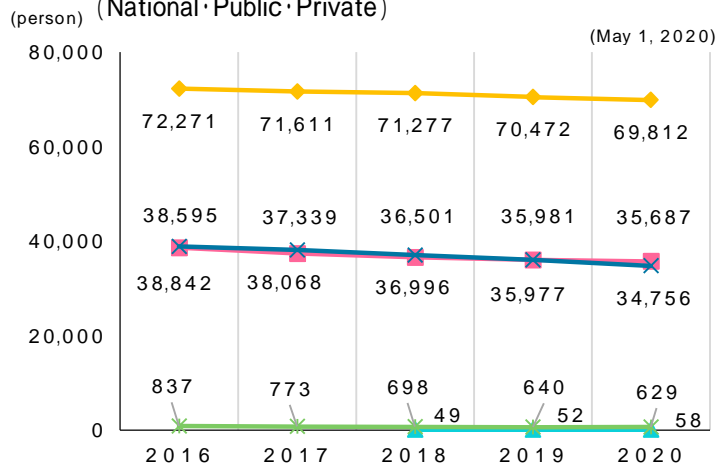

Changes in the Number of Students

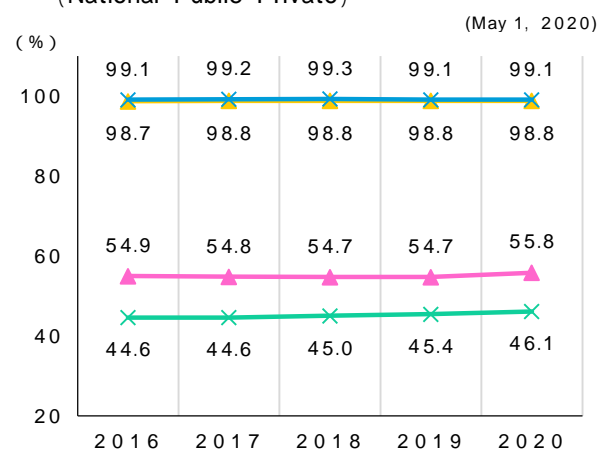

(National · Public · Private)

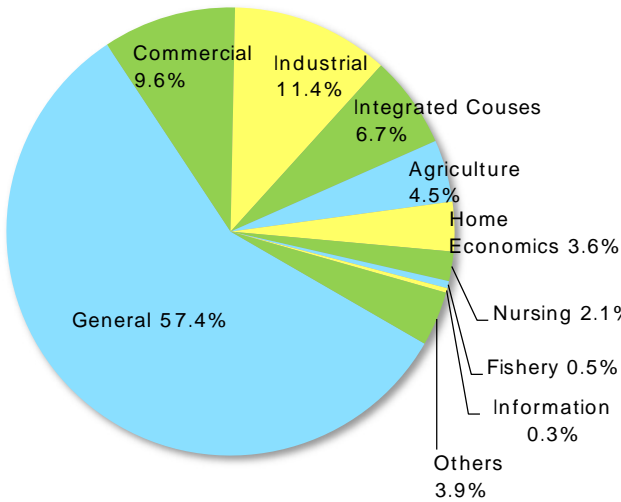

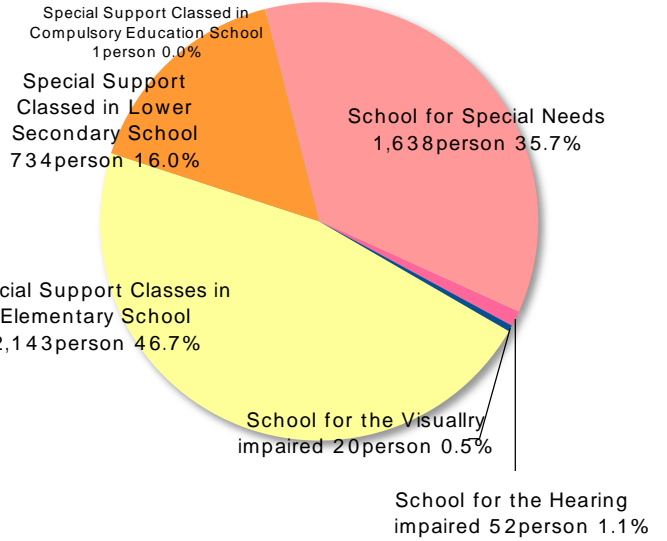

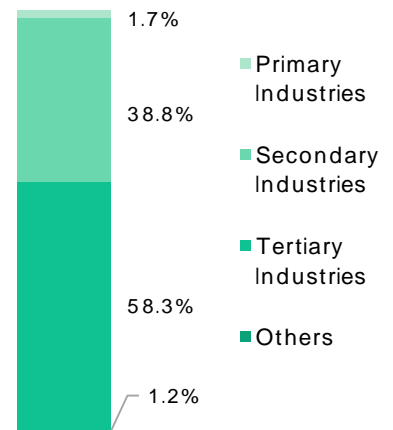

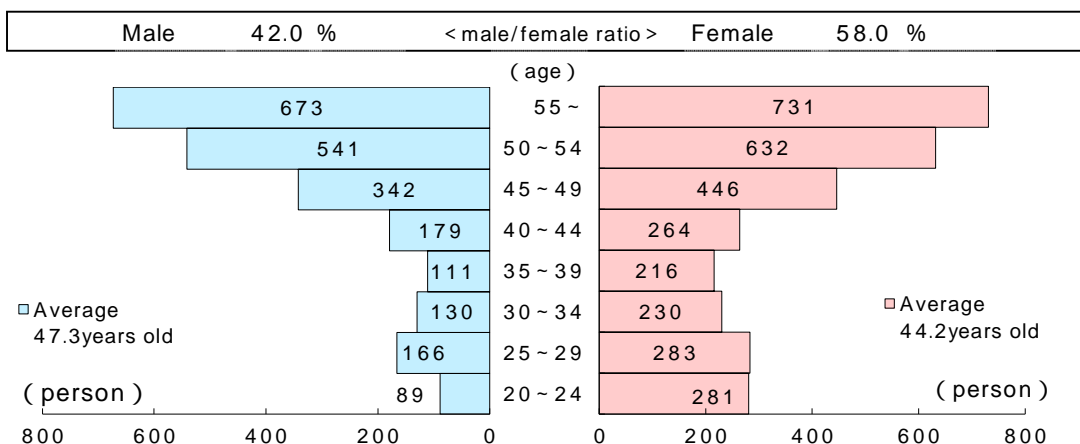

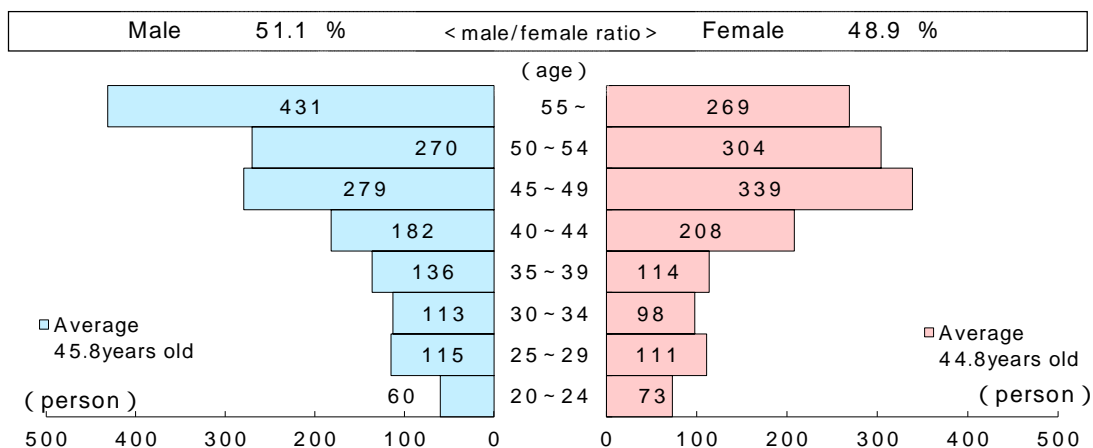
Number of Teachers , by Age

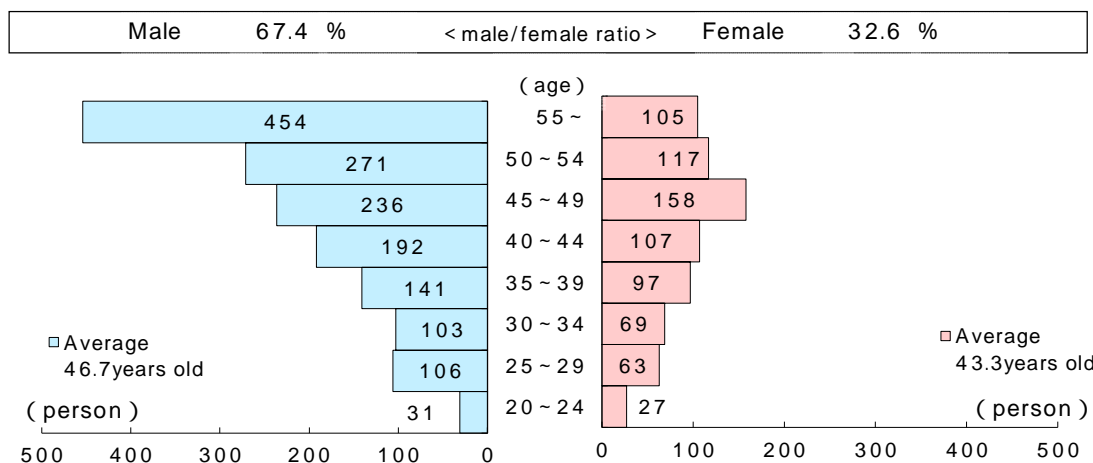

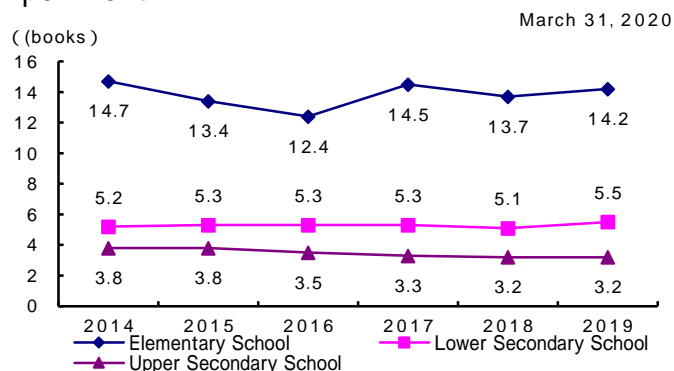

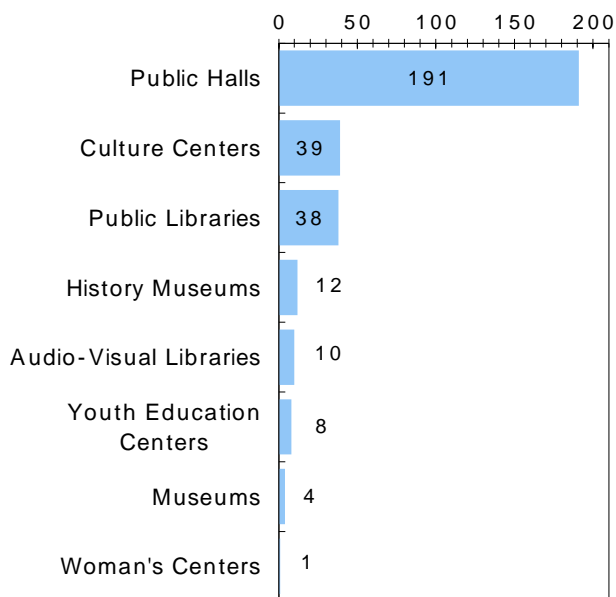

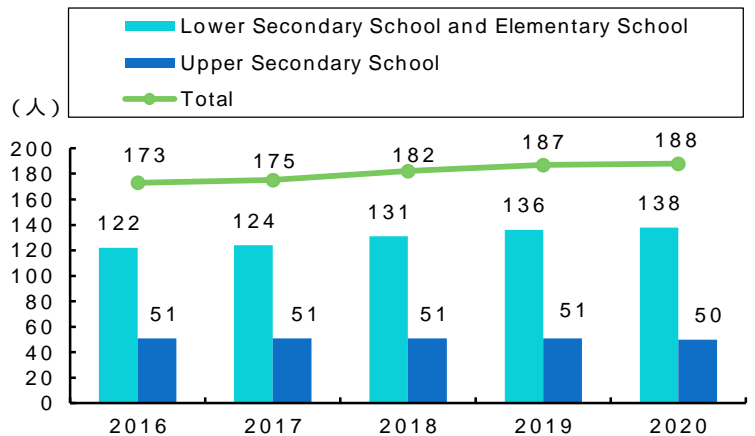

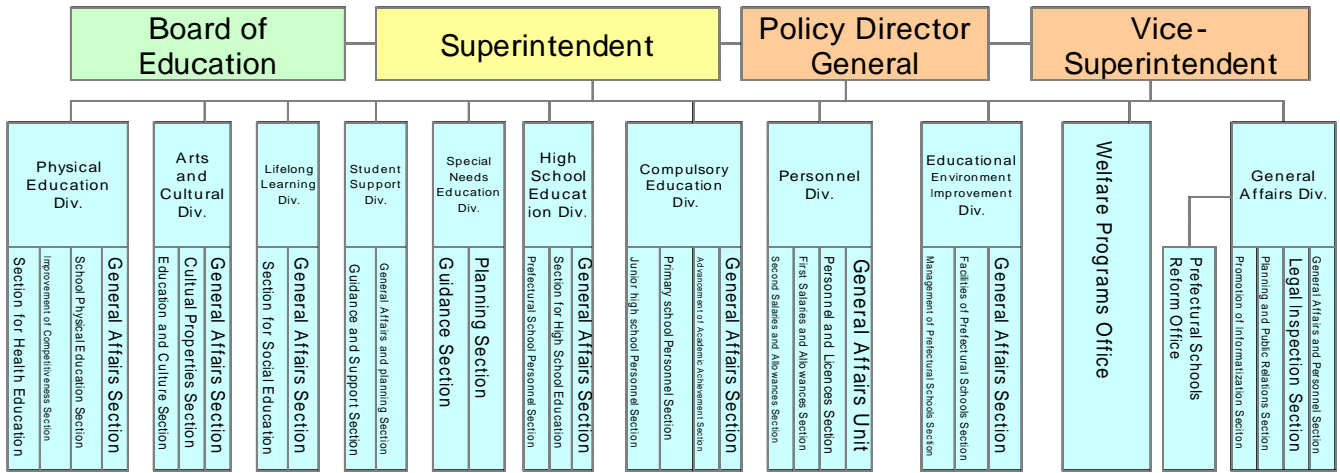
